

# **HOW TO APPLY**

Review Protégé School admission requirements:
 Step 1: Select the Program you want to study

Protégé offers Diploma programs

- (i) Massage Therapy
- (ii) Esthetics
- (iii) Medical Esthetics

#### Step 2: Admission Requirements

- Applicant must be at least 19 years of age.
- A completed Protégé School International Application Form
- A photocopy of your Passport or birth certificate
- An application fee of \$100 (Canadian dollars) made payable to Protégé School by international money order. (Non-refundable)
- Academic credentials requirements for international student: with an achieved academic standing equal to 12 years of primary and secondary education or completion of a college or university post-secondary programs.
- If English is not the applicant's 1st language, Proof of English Language Proficiency is required as follows for consideration:
- Minimum TOEFL(Test of English as a Foreign Language) score is 20 in each of the four components (listening, speaking, writing and reading)

OR

Minimum I.E.L.T.S. (International English Language Testing System) score is 6.0

OR

Minimum CanTest (Canadian Standardized English Proficiency Test) score is 3.5.

For applicant does not achieving the above bench mark of the English Proficiency requirements will be required to take Protégé English as second language course.

- 2. Compile all required documents:
  - Copies of original certified secondary school graduation transcripts for diploma and degree programs and/or any college or university

transcripts for post-secondary programs and degrees.

- All documents must be accompanied by a notarized, official translation into English (where applicable).
- Proof of English language proficiency (i.e. TOEFL, IELTS, CanTest) must be submitted as well.

This International Student Health Insurance is provided through Protégé School's insurance provider A.T. Financial Group Inc. for accident and illness coverage, plan may include dental emergencies. A CAD\$440.00 insurance fee is charged to international student for 32-weeks Esthetics program and a CAD\$1,155.00 for a 88-weeks Massage Therapy Program)

# Preparing for Your Arrival

Make sure you have all that you need for your arrival in Canada.

## > Important documents

- valid passport, study permit, visa, and letter of Acceptance from Protégé.
- Address of your chosen accommodation in Canada
- Other important items: Cash (if you are planning to carry more than CAD\$10,1000, you must declare to the CBSA, failure to report will result in penalties, seizure and/or prosecution); Credit Cards; Immunization and Medical reports (must be in English or French); at least one more piece of your Identification other than of your passport; Driver's licence/International Driver's Licence and Insurance record (if you plan to drive and/or bring your car into Canada)

#### Clothing

You need to bring appropriate clothing for Canadian cold and warm weathers. Fall and Winter temperatures range from 15C (60F) to 25C (80F); Fall and Winter Temperatures are usually slight below freezing, but December to February are the coldest months in most parts of Canada, temperatures can drop to way below freezing.

#### Customs

- You are not allowed to bring any food into Canada
- If you are planning to bring valuable goods such as electronic items, car, into Canada, make a list of these goods with their serial number, model, make and the approximate value in Canadian funds.
